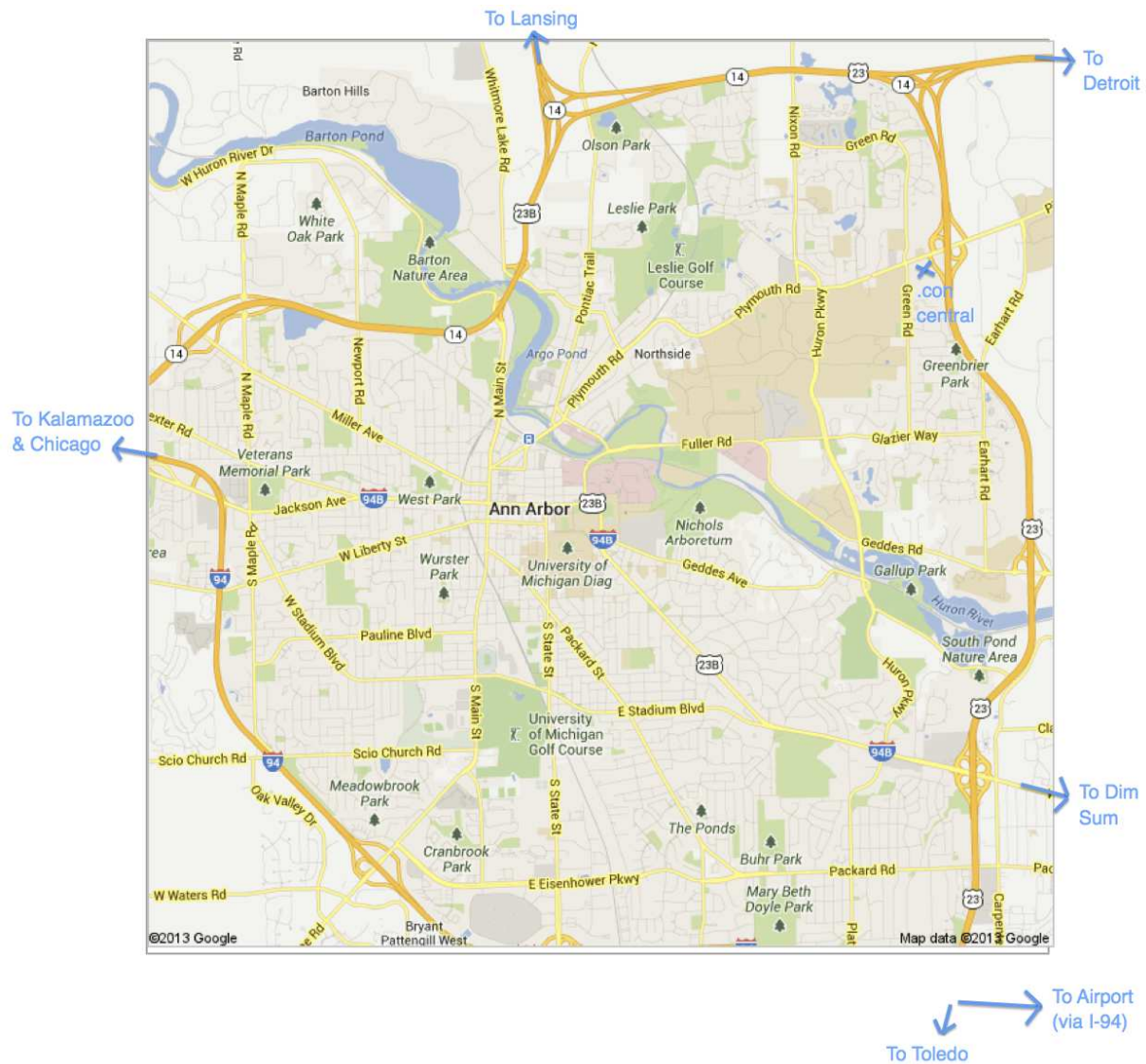


Navigating Ann Arbor

Ann Arbor is surrounded by three highways that act as a beltway:

- U.S. 23 on the east – right next to Con Central
- I-94 on the south and west – runs between Chicago and Detroit (including the airport)
- Michigan 14 on the north and northwest – runs to Detroit more directly

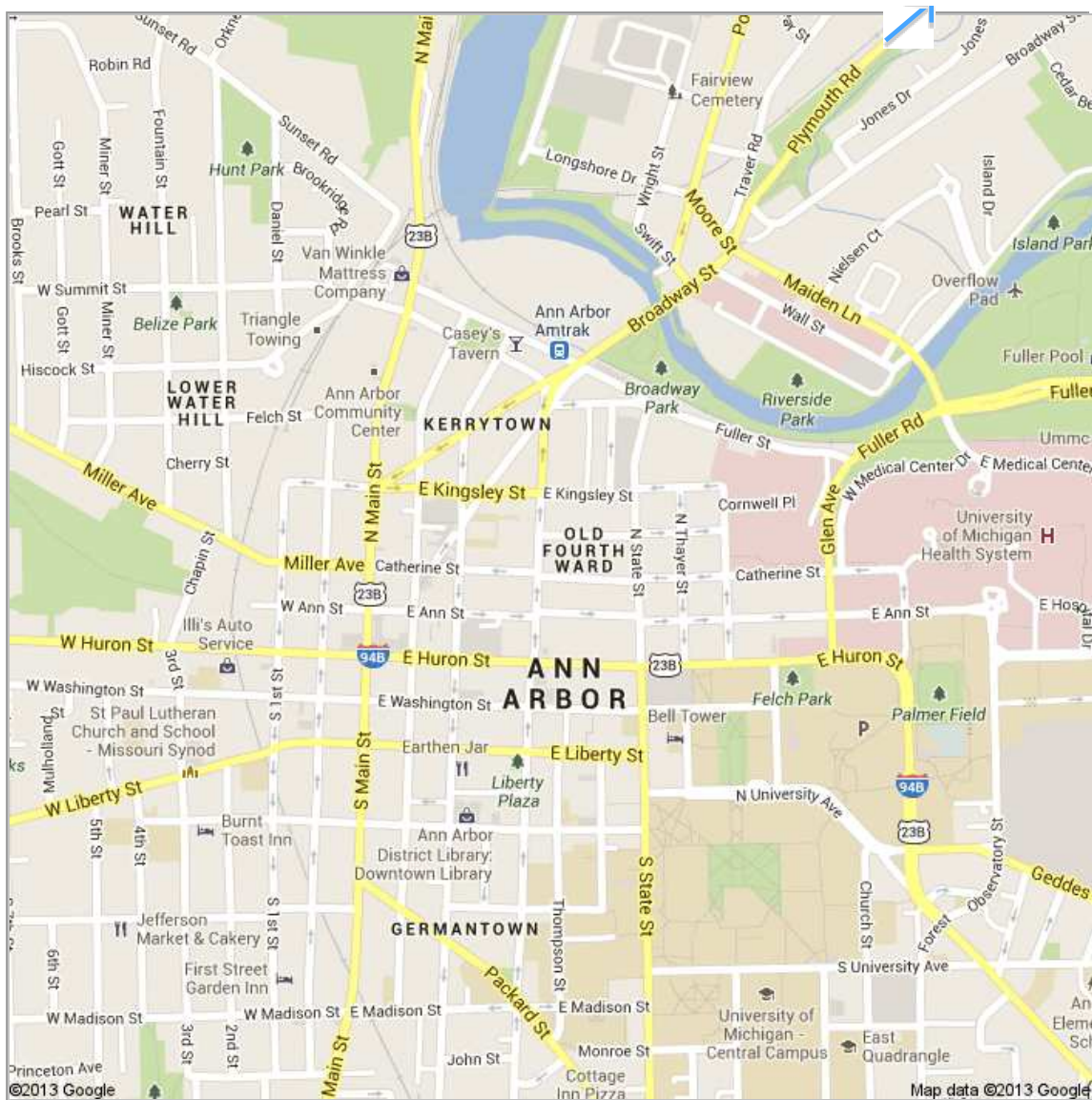


Plymouth Road is the primary way to get downtown. Inbound, Plymouth turns into Beakes St, which meets Main St after about 5 blocks. To get back to Plymouth, because of one-ways, you need to turn from Main onto Kingsley and then left onto Division.

Streets in downtown Ann Arbor follow a grid pattern. Street numbers start counting North or South of Huron St, and East and West of Main St. Numbered **streets** are West of Main and numbered **avenues** are East of Main, but their numbers do **not** correspond to their distance from Main Street.

Parking at the hotel is free. Parking in Downtown Ann Arbor is \$1.50 at parking meters and slightly cheaper at parking lots/structures.¹ Full list of paid parking options at: http://www.a2dda.org/downloads/Maps/ShortTerm_ParkingOptions.pdf

In Detroit, for security, be sure to park in a lot or structure that has an attendant.
